They also replaced roof supports and part of the roof for a single mom and her family. This was a huge blessing as it's rainy season now and water was coming into their house every time it rained. Then they added a bedroom to the house of a family of 5 who only had 2 bedrooms they were sharing.

We also hosted a day where we taught families to make jewelry in the hopes that they may continue to do this as a way to support themselves.

We praise the Lord for the blessing of serving with a great group who worked to care for both future teams and the families who are so special to all of us. The love and hope of Christ was shared with many people and for this we are so grateful!
