Missy is on the mend! Her last class just ended and she now has one and a half months to not worry about school work which affords her time to keep recovering from illness and catch up on things she wasn't able to attend to while in school. She is still maintaining a 4.0 and has already begun applying what she is learning to helping others!

Dylan continues to lead spiritual direction classes in the church and is beginning a new Celebrate Recovery study with a recovering alcoholic from one of the families we serve through the SARF ministry. We have been praying for years to see progress in this man's life and are grateful to start to see some breakthrough. Before our May team Dylan took him to a rehab center but he only stayed for 5 days. Even though this was disheartening, Jorge is still sober 2 months later! Dylan has been spending more time with him to grow closer to him in order to start this discipleship program. The greatest obstacle we face, however, is that Jorge is illiterate. So, Dylan will need to adapt the material through auditory teaching only, as it is a written program meant to be studied throughout the week from the book.
